**6) Pre-consultation:**

ESN40151 Land off Hawkley Road, Hawkley Liss

*EE Emergency Services Network (ESN) proposed base station installation*

The site is considered ideal, indeed an improvement in terms of its visual impact on the site previously agreed with Vodaphone but whose application does not appear to be progressing.

Councillors therefore welcome the proposal but with one significant caveat: the mast must provide not only a vital communication tool for the emergency services but must also provide a mobile phone signal for residents and visitors using the EE network. As this location is considered the best site in the parish, parish councillors could not support the proposal if this assurance is not forthcoming.

**7) Activity on land south of Spring House, Stairs Hill**

Concerns about activity on this site have not gone away. EHDC Planning Enforcement department has visited the site and has undertaken to continue to do so in order to ensure that the terms of the planning application are adhered to. Clerk to continue to liaise with the relevant officer.
